
We are a network of missionaries, churches and missions committed to using education as a tool to see people turn to Christ and be transformed into His image.

Planning an integrated church plant effort

The Transformational Education Network is prepared to come alongside church planters to help establish computer training schools in an integrated church planting effort. Here are ways we will work with you:

—Prayer. We meet weekly via Skype and will prayerfully seek the Lord's leading and blessing in this endeavor. We also pray fervently and effectively individually for TEN3 matters and this would be a priority for all of us to take before the Lord.

—Planning. We help you develop plans for equipment needs, financial viability, staff development and class scheduling.

—Training. We provide training for the teachers, administrators and board members of the computer training schools.

—Consulting. We will assign a consultant who will guide you through the process from startup to accreditation. We also answer your questions and help solve problems.

—Curriculum. We provide the Christ-centered curriculum that has helped transform the lives of a significant number of students.

Our vision of how it will work

One of the primary questions of any church planting effort is how to reach people in a selected community. Outreach can be a daunting, intimidating effort. This is why we think the integrated church planting approach with a TEN3 computer training outreach school is such a natural fit.

A computer school is a natural draw for residents across Africa. What sets our schools apart is how easily accessible they are to residents and their affordability. Most importantly is the curriculum's emphasis on the gospel and the instilling of a sound Christian world view through a chronological understanding of God's redemptive plan for the world.

Our materials are evangelistic and appealing to non-Christians. For teachers, we will train and mentor you so that you will be ready to launch the school alongside the church planting effort. We recognize that it's going to take a level of financial commitment to start the schools. We are willing to help identify sources of equipment to launch the schools and provide the startup tools such as training. Remember, though, our schools can also be income generators through affordable student tuition fees to help fund the church planting effort.
